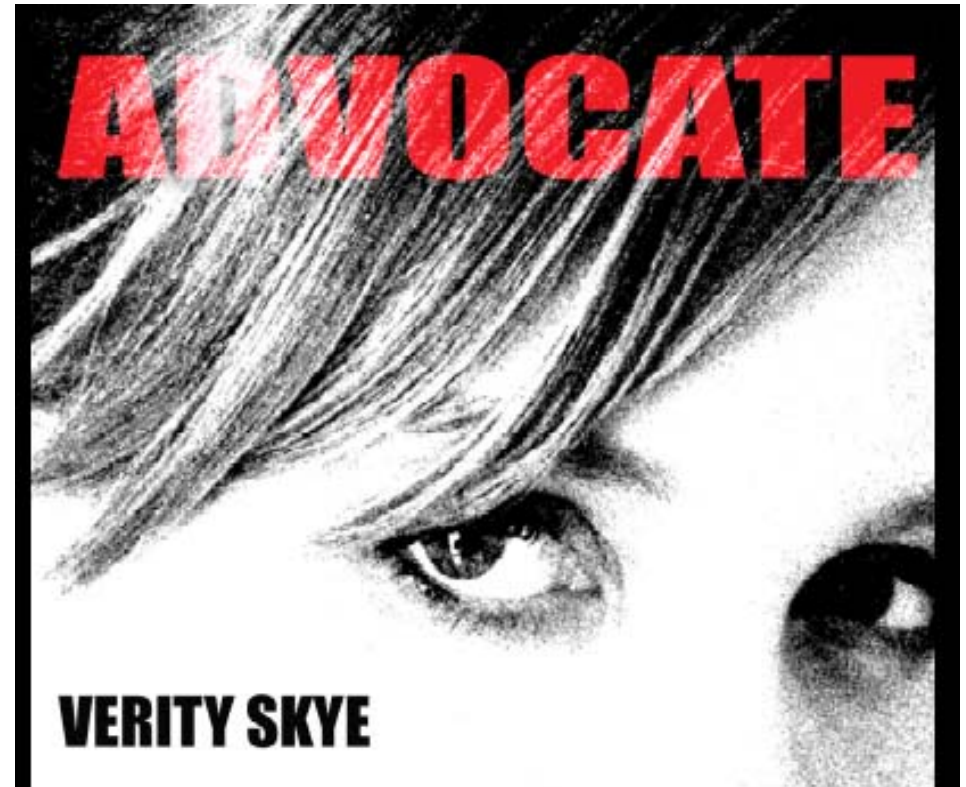
## BIRTHDAY BRICKS FOR KITGUM
